## HISTORY

Greenway's Melrose Trading Post is an ongoing fundraiser for Fairfax High School. State budget cuts have cost the Los Angeles public school system millions of dollars, which funded the arts, after school programs, and "luxuries" such as computers, sports uniforms, a parent center, campus beautification projects, and scholarships. ## FAQ's

### **What type of market is this and what time does it open?**

Greenway's Melrose Trading Post is a market of antiques, collectibles, one-of-a-kind merchandise and handmade arts and crafts.

The market is open every Sunday, rain or shine, from 9am-5pm, and features live music.

### **How do I get a space?**

To be considered for a space, you must sell antiques, collectibles, furniture, or handmade arts and crafts. Items prohibited include drug paraphernalia, weapons, replicas, adult material, food or drinks. The ability to sell in the market on a consistent basis depends upon the mix in the market. Due to the high volume of vendors interested in selling there is a waiting list. You can also come through standby early in the morning.

### **How does Standby work and where do I go?**

Enter through the Fairfax and Clinton gate between 5:30AM and 7:30AM to join the line. Standby vendors must have a driver license to sell, and all vendors must have a California Sellers Permit after their second time selling at the market.

Standby vendors stay in the car until MTP management has come and placed you on the Standby Line list. At 7:45AM, MTP Management calls all standby vendors up to the table and sells each Standby vendor a space that is declared empty for that day. All standby vendors must be in the market, setting up no later than 9AM. All Vendor vehicles must be out by 8:50AM.

No vendor vehicles may enter the market after 8:30AM.

### **Can I pay with a check on standby?**

No. Standbys can only pay with cash or credit card.

### **Once I get into the market can I buy a space for the next week or the week after?**

If you're booked from the waiting list, your merchandise will be evaluated the day you sell. You must let the Vendor Manager know if you want to be put on the waiting list or if you are interested in a permanent space. Only permanent vendors can sign up for the following week and must pay by check, Money Order, credit card (no cash) or by using our PayPal online payment system. ### **What is a permanent vendor?**

A permanent vendor sells consistently 1-5 Sundays per month in the same location. Not all vendors are eligible to be a regular, permanent vendor the number of days you are approved to sell at the market is based upon the merchandise and availability in the market.

### **How much is it to rent a booth?**

The size and price of a regular space are 10x10 (\$60) 10x20 (\$65) & 20x20 (\$75). We have one section priced higher, due to the higher volume of traffic: 10x10 (\$75), 10x20 (\$90) and 20x20 (\$110)

Tents and table are also available for rent (while supplies last, so reserve early!) Tents (\$25) Tables(\$10) and Chairs (\$5) 1 tent, 1 table and 2 chairs for \$40.
